






Second Floor UH SERC Buildout - Phase 081908







#### Description of State Procurement Categories

Building Construction - Expenses directly associated with construction of a building, such as architecture and engineering services, site surveys and testing, and equipment and furniture that are originally installed in a new building.

Commodity Purchasing - Computer equipment, office supplies, research supplies, teaching supplies, software, furniture (not installed in a new building), vehicles, and other tangible personal property.

Other Services - Electronic information services available at campus libraries, insurance, repair and maintenance contracts for equipment and software, temporary personnel services, food services, and consulting services.

Professional Services - Engineering and architecture services not related to new construction, external auditing services, and medical services for the UH Health Clinic and athletes.

Special Trade - Expenses related to repairing and maintaining buildings and associated trades, such as plumbers, electricians, painters, etc.
